Grapes were carefully selected from fog-influenced vineyards across the expansive Central Coast, one of the most diverse and climatically cool grape growing regions in California.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The 2018 growing season started off with cooler temperatures which was followed by a moderate summer with fewer heat spikes than normal. Fruit set was consistent and with the milder weather, harvest began a few weeks later compared to the last few years. This longer and near-perfect growing season has resulted in structured and concentrated wines.

WINEMAKER NOTES

This 2018 Pinot Noir unlocks the hidden side of the Central Coast with vibrant red fruit aromas of Bing cherry, rhubarb and raspberries. Bright flavors of fresh strawberry and blueberries are complemented with cardamom spice and notes of black tea. Balanced acidity and well-integrated tannins lead to a long and delicious finish.
