



2019 Monterey Pinot Noir

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

Heavy spring rains enriched the soils and delayed bud break by a few weeks. A heat spike in June, followed by warm weather, brought even veraison throughout the vineyards. A cooling trend and touch of rain in mid-September created ideal conditions for the 2019 harvest which is considered a near-perfect vintage.

TASTING NOTES

The grapes for this 2019 Pinot Noir were harvested in the cool morning hours to retain freshness and preserve the purity of the flavors. Bright and fresh aromas of Bing cherry and strawberry are layered with notes of violet and baking spice. Rich flavors coat the palate with raspberry, plum, Bergamot tea and a touch of oak. This is a beautifully structured wine with balanced acidity and a lingering finish.
