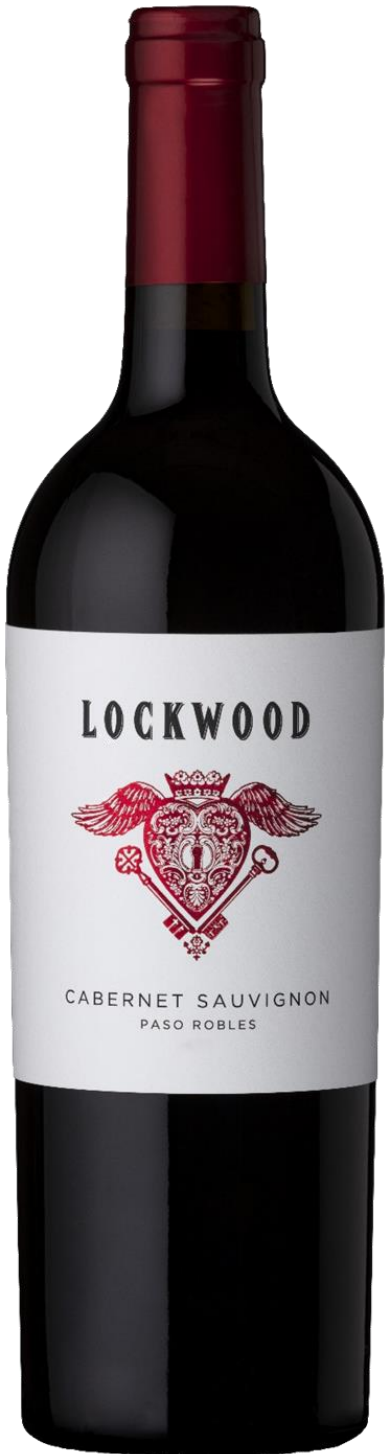
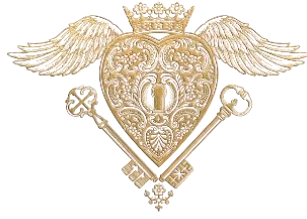

2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON PASO ROBLES

IN THE VINEYARDS

Grapes were carefully selected from vineyards within the diverse Paso Robles AVA. A wine region for the wild-hearted, this beautiful Cabernet Sauvignon unlocks the hidden beauty of its unique terroir.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

Heavy spring rains enriched the soils and delayed bud break by a few weeks. A heat spike in June, followed by warm weather, brought even veraison throughout the vineyards. A cooling trend and touch of rain in mid-September created ideal conditions for the 2019 harvest which is considered a near-perfect vintage.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Harvested in the cool morning hours, the grapes were selectively blended together to develop complexity before being aged in a combination of stainless steel and French oak barrels.

The 2019 Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon opens with currant, black cherry and cedar notes on the nose. This is a well-balanced wine with rich flavors of sweet cherry, boysenberry and cocoa with a hint of white pepper and eucalyptus. Fine-grained tannins and a plush mouthfeel lead to a long and silky finish.
